



# Gregor Reid Award for Outstanding Scholars in Developing Nations

## Now inviting applications for the 2026 award!

To honor Dr. Gregor Reid, former President of ISAPP, and founder of the ISAPP Students and Fellows Association (SFA), this award recognizes and supports early career researchers (students and fellows) within LMICs, echoing Dr. Reid's commitment to scientific excellence, innovation, and community development.

### Award

The winner receives a plaque, speaking slot at the annual ISAPP meeting, travel award to the ISAPP meeting, and an unrestricted cash award (\$1500 USD).

### Eligibility & Selection Criteria

- Applicants may include graduate students (enrolled in full-time MSc/PhD degree or equivalent) and postdoctoral fellows (within 3 years of their terminal degree or doctorate)
- Applicants must reside and be enrolled/employed in a country or territory with a DAC ranking of Low (L) or Low-Middle (LM) income.
- Applicants must register as members of the Students and Fellows Association (SFA) of ISAPP.
- The key criteria for the award is scientific merit and impact.
- The research performed by the applicant within the past 1-2 years must be on probiotics, prebiotics, postbiotics, synbiotics, fermented foods, or other microbiome or biotic-related areas of interest.
